Subcellular location: Cytoplasm. Nucleus. *NOTE*: Mainly cytoplasmic but can be relocalized to the nucleus.

Three antibodies: GMNN-1, GMNN-2 and GMNN-3 were tested. GMNN-1 was approved for IHC and selected for full protein profiling.


