Full name: Cystatin-B

Protein existence: evidence at protein level

Function: This is an intracellular thiol proteinase inhibitor. Tightly binding reversible inhibitor of cathepsins L, H and B.

Subcellular location: Cytoplasm. Nucleus.

Three antibodies: CSTB-1, CSTB-2 and CSTB-3 were tested. All three antibodies were approved for IHC. CSTB-3 was selected for full protein profiling.

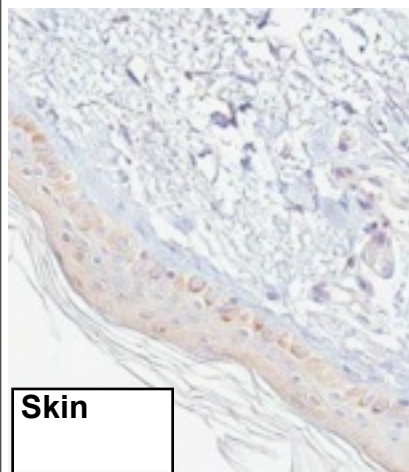

### Immunohistochemistry

IHC protocol: HIER pH 6, Dilution 1:250

IHC test staining: **Strong cytoplasmic staining of squamous epithelia in tonsil. Very weak staining in a few tissues .**



### Western blot

WB Size markers (kDa): 250, 130, 95, 72, 55, 36, 28, 17, 11

WB Lanes: Marker(1), RT-4(2), U251 MG(3), Plasma(4), Liver(5), Tonsil(6)

WB Target weight (kDa): 11

WB Validation: Supportive (Band of predicted size in kDa (+/-20%) with additional bands present.)
